Subject: ICC Certificate of Authority for Norfolk Southern Railway Company

Thank you for your recent email with regards to Interstate Commerce Commission (ICC) certificate of Authority for Norfolk Southern Railway Company.

As you know, the ICC preceded the Surface Transportation Board (STB). Under the laws involving the regulation of railroads, the STB, and the ICC before it, grants authority to acquire, operate, control, merger, trackage rights and lease under Title 49 United States Code sections 10501, 11323-11325. However, a certificate was never issued to Norfolk Southern Railway, per se, but the authority to acquire, to merge and to operate over the lines in Norfolk Southern System had been granted by the ICC and, now the STB over many years.

Railroads must provide and update annually their system's diagram map of all the lines that they have been granted authority that may go back as far as 1887 when the ICC came into existence. Consequently, each line (or lines) of right of way was (or were) a subject of a decision and authorization by the ICC and the STB. So, there is no one certificate that Norfolk Southern has but a series of many decisions and authority to operate over their vast network of rail lines.
